The Translation and Interpretation Department of Federal Defenders of San Diego, Inc. -- the Community Defender Organization for the Southern District of California -- seeks applicants for a full-time staff position. An eligible applicant must be qualified by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts as a Certified Court Interpreter for Spanish/English proceedings.

Salary: This is a full-time position with salary based upon experience and in accord with administrative guidelines currently yielding from JS 9/1 \$56,084 to JS 14/10 \$148,572. Direct deposit of pay required. Benefits available include: medical, dental, vision, life insurance, 401(k), and flexible spending accounts.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Interprets in simultaneous and consecutive modes at all stages of a criminal defense case for defendants, witnesses and attorneys in office, jail and courthouse settings;
- Translates documents written in colloquial, legal, official, scientific and technical language;
- Accurately transcribes the interpretation of evidentiary recordings, including law enforcement interviews and wiretaps;
- Certifies and testifies to the accuracy of evidence translated or interpreted by other parties;
- Develops professional expertise and remains impartial and neutral in providing translation and interpretation services.
