We need a full-time Assistant Federal Public Defender to represent clients in a fast-paced, challenging, diverse, and rewarding work environment. Responsibilities include managing an extensive caseload; working closely with clients; interviewing witnesses and family members; developing release plans; reviewing discovery; preparing pleadings, motions, and briefs; developing litigation strategies; working with experts; assisting CJA panel attorneys; and in-court litigation through all stages of a criminal case. Some travel is necessary. Attorneys in our office may not engage in the private practice of law.

Salary and Benefits

Salary is based on experience, with a starting range of \$90,000 to \$110,000, and the potential for promotion. The position is full-time with federal benefits, including health and life insurance, retirement, and the Thrift Savings Plan. Salary is payable only by direct deposit. A final offer of employment is subject to a background check.
